Program Highlights

- The regular season will consist of 10-12 matches.
- Games will be played on weekends in June/July.
- Practice will be held twice per week.
- Training will begin in May/June.
- Rosters can be up to 26 players, only 18 can dress for each match. Injuries and summer commitments (vacation, ODP regional camp, soccer camps, etc.) typically prevent teams from having an issue with too many available players.
- The total point leader from each division will qualify for the Super Y-League North American Finals.
- The Super Y-League North American Finals will be held in early December outside Tampa, FL.

When are Super Y tryouts?

Tryouts will be held January 28th at the Polo Fields located at 6050 Majors Rd., Cumming, GA 30040
TIME: 10:00 a.m.-12:00 p.m. Check In: 9:30 a.m.

When does Super Y begin?

First games can be played as early as May, however, UFA will not start playing games until June.

How many practices will each team have?

Each team will have 2 sessions per week, with practices beginning the week of June 12th, and continue through the first week in August, with the exception of the week of July 4th.

Where are Super Y practices?

Practices will be scheduled at the Polo Fields and Summerour; all home games will be at the Polo Fields.

How many games do we play?

UFA participates in the South Atlantic Division of Super Y. We won't know exactly what clubs are participating until some time in March. However, the clubs that participated last year in our division were Atlanta United, Atlanta Metros, Alpharetta Ambush, DDY, Tennessee Soccer Club, and Gulf Coast Texans.

How much will we have to travel?

Until each club submits their participation agreement, we won't know exactly, however, we do not anticipate more than 2-3 weekends of travel.

What if I miss practices or games due to vacation?

Each team will target a large enough roster that accounts for players missing practices and/or games. The objective is to have scheduled training available during the summer for those players that want to continue to train and play games while they are home during the summer.

What is the cost and what does it include?

The cost for 7v7 and 9v9 playing formats is \$325 (\$350 for non-UFA players)

The cost for 11v11 format is \$375 (\$400 for non-UFA players)

Cost includes administration fees, coaching fees, league, player and coach registration fees, field rental costs, and referee fees.
