Age Group Rules

U7 & U8

- A referee will be assigned to officiate the games
- No coaches are allowed on the field.
- Coaches must remain on the sideline, and may not be behind either goal
- Size of ball: Number 3
- (4) Twelve minute quarters
- Stop play at a dead ball close to the twelve minute mark for subs
- Goalies must have different color jersey than team (may be penny or t-shirt)
- Five players on the field from each team in each quarter
- Substitutions can be made during the following:
 - a) At 12-minute mark in each quarter
 - b) At half time
 - c) In case of an injury
- Offside Rule not in effect
- No "Slide Tackling"- This is a difficult technique and can be dangerous at this age
- All free kicks will be indirect
- No penalty kicks. Fouls inside the penalty area result in an indirect free kick
- Handballs will be called
- Be very forgiving in calling fouls, especially inadvertent handballs
- Throw-ins will be used. A second chance will be given to make a good throw-in
- Each player must play at least half a game
- **All parents must sit on one side of field opposite the coaches and teams and may not be behind either goal**
- **Each team must use four different players as goalie in each game(a different player for each quarter in a game)**

U10

- A referee will be assigned to officiate the games
- No coaches are allowed on the field.
- Coaches must remain on the sideline, and may not be behind either goal
- No "Slide Tackling"- This is a difficult technique and can be dangerous at this age
- Size of ball played: Number 4
- (2) Thirty minute halves
- Six players on the field from each team in each half
- Goalies must have different color jersey than team (may be penny or t-shirt)
- Substitutions can be made during the following:
 - a) When your team is in possession of a throw-in
 - b) There is a goal kick by either team
 - c) At half time
 - d) In case of an injury
- Offside Rule is in effect
- Direct kicks will be allowed

- Penalty kicks are in effect. Fouls inside the penalty area may result in a direct free kick.
- Handballs will be called.
- Throw-ins will be used, and a second chance will not be given.
- Each player must play at least half a game.
- All parents must sit on one side of field opposite the coaches and teams, and may not sit behind either goal.

U12

- Eight players on the field from each team
- Size of ball: Number 4
- (2) Thirty minute halves

U14

- Eleven players on the field from each team
- Size of ball: Number 5

General Rules

- **Playing Time:** Each player MUST play a minimum of 50% of the total playing time. A player who is late forfeits the right to make up for the time missed. (Rec Only)
- **Team Format:** Recreational teams may be coed. They will only be gender related based on a high number of participants. Academy and Select teams will mainly be gender related.
- **Roster Limit:** **U6** – 4 to 6, **U8** – 5 to 8, **U10** – 7 to 10, **U11/U12** – 9 to 12, **U13 & up** – 12 to 15.
- **Standings:** Game scores will not be kept for Recreational and Academy teams.
- **U6:** Will have a coach per team on the field.
- **Sitting Location:** All parents must sit on one side of field opposite the coaches and teams, and may not sit behind either goal.
- **Forfeits:** U6 to U10 recreational teams will not forfeit games based on the number of players attending. If a team is below the minimum number of players, the game will be played at even strength or with both teams sharing players.
